Through continuously striving to reduce the environmental impact of our operations and activities, AFM commits to:

COMMUNICATION

Promote environmental sustainability by favouring online communication wherever possible, and minimising the use of printed materials. We share our sustainability policies and initiatives with members through AFM's Sustainable Mutual Insurance online forum.



ENERGY AND WATER MANAGEMENT

Integrate carbon reduction, including efficient use of water and energy, in all our operations, and encourage those with whom we collaborate to do the same.

WASTE (RESOURCE) MANAGEMENT

Integrate waste (resource) management into our operations, encouraging staff to adopt the waste hierarchy of prevention, reuse, recycling and recovery in order to reduce waste to landfill.



TRAVEL AND TRANSPORT

Promote the use of sustainable travel options wherever possible, locating AFM events with this in mind and encouraging members to do the same. Assess the approach to sustainability when selecting external host venues.

SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT

Carefully select the partners we work with to ensure they support similar sustainability aims. As well as considering this in the way we appoint new members, this also includes the way we select suppliers and investment managers.
